Eliminating Tardiness: We would like to remind parents and students of our tardy policy and the importance of arriving to class on time. Our PBIS Committee (Positive Behavioral Interventions Support) has been working on reducing the number of tardies throughout the school day. When a student arrives late, he/she misses out on essential instructions given at the beginning of the lesson. This can significantly reduce achievement, regardless of academic ability.

We are asking for your cooperation and support to ensure that your son/daughter arrives on time every day to all their classes.
